

For online information on public transportation in Munich we strongly recommend you download the **MVG Fahrinfo München** App which is available in the Apple Store and Google Play Store. This is extremely important as presently there is a strong disruption due to urgent work on the switch system south of the Sendlinger Tor, where the subway station will be completely renewed. This interrupts the U6 subway line services (the line to the Congress Venue!) in the city center.

There are different options for public transportation to the Galileo Science Congress Center Munich-Garching, yet we describe only the simplest one.

- From **Munich Airport** to the **Congress Center**:

Option 1: Take the S1 to Neufahrn and then the bus line 690 to Garching Forschungszentrum (*about 40 minutes*)

Option 2: Take the S8 to Ismaning and then the bus line 230 to Garching Forschungszentrum (*about 40 minutes*)

- From **Munich Airport** to **downtown Munich**:

If you have your hotel downtown Munich you take either S1 or S8 to the city center (*about 40 minutes*).

- From the **railway-stations** to the **Congress Center**:

From **Munich Hauptbahnhof (Central Station)** or **Munich East** you go to **Marienplatz** by S-Bahn, you can take any line.

At Marienplatz change to the **Shuttle Train** which commutes to **Odeonsplatz** (one stop). Be sure that you do not go in the wrong direction to Sendlinger Tor!).

At **Odeonsplatz** (end station of the Shuttle Train), you change on the same platform to **U6 to Garching Forschungszentrum**. The Congress Center is directly at the exit of the U-Bahn station.

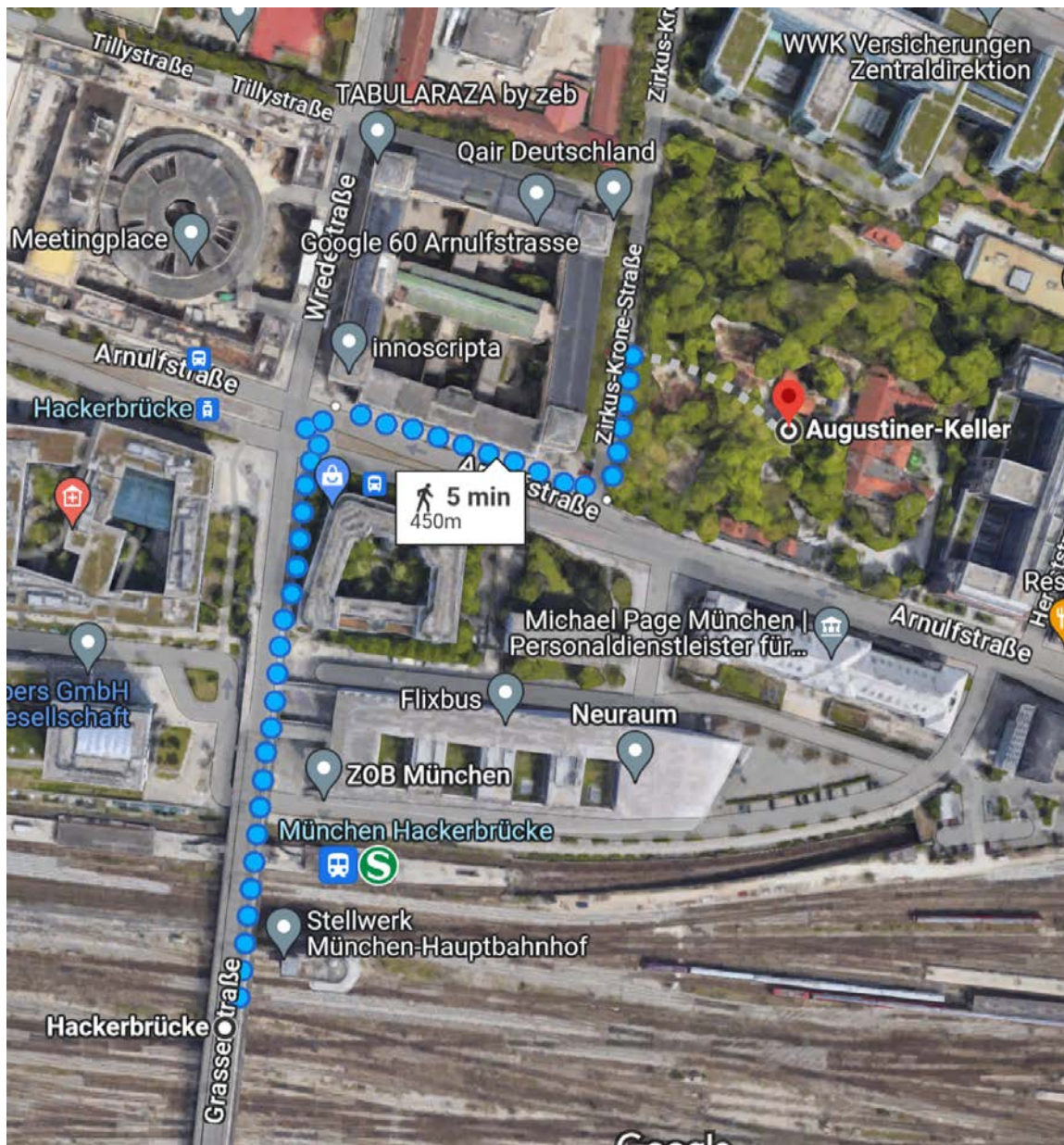
From Hauptbahnhof to the Congress Center, the trip takes about 35 minutes, from Ostbahnhof 40 minutes.

- From **Garching Forschungszentrum** to the venue of the Conference Dinner (**Augustinerkeller**)

You go the opposite direction as described above towards Munich Hauptbahnhof:

Garching Forschungszentrum → Odeonsplatz by U-Bahn → Marienplatz by Shuttle Train → S-Bahn direction Hauptbahnhof), but you exit **one stop after Hauptbahnhof**, at S-Bahn Station **Hackerbrücke**. Every S-Bahn from Marienplatz stops there.

From Hackerbrücke it is a five minutes walk to the Augustiner Keller (see map).



The total trip should take you about 40 minutes.

If your hotel is located south of the center of Munich, you need to consult the **MVG Fahrinfo München**, because there are too many options depending on the precise location.
